

Agency Voter Registration

Eligibility: To Register to Vote in Nebraska you must:

- Be a United States Citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age or will be 18 years of age on or before the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November
- Live in the State of Nebraska
- Have not been convicted of a felony or, if convicted, civil rights have been restored
- Have not been officially found to be mentally incompetent

If you do not check either answer you will be considered to have decided not to register to vote at this time.

Applying to register to or declining to register to vote will not affect the amount of assistance or services that you will be provided by this agency.

If you believe that someone has interfered with your right to register or to decline to register to vote, or your right to choose your own, political party or other political preference, you may file a complaint with the:
