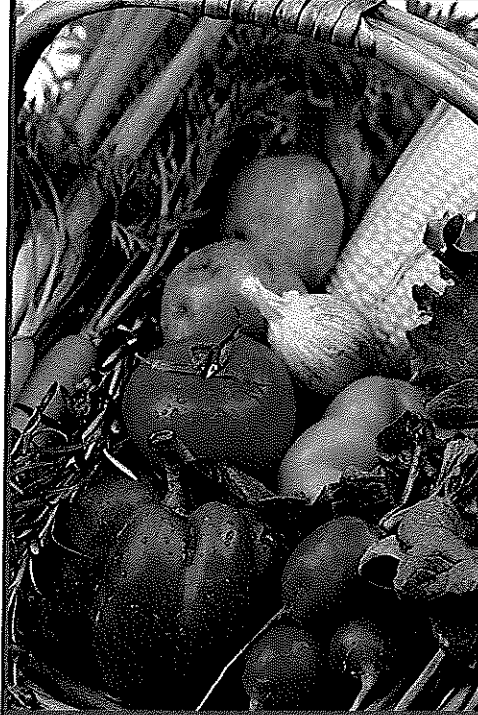


The Community Market Basket Project

PROJECT GOALS:

1. Make farm fresh food accessible.
2. Connect consumers with farmers & growers; connect farmers and growers with communities in need.
3. Provide seasonal food preparation and preservation training.
4. Help families in need to stretch food dollars.



The Community Market Basket Project is an extension of an existing CSA (Community Supported Agriculture) program through Tomāto Tomāto.

PROJECT DETAILS:

1. **Cost:** \$10/week for SNAP recipients; \$20/week for others.
2. **Delivered** weekly from June 1—Nov. 1, 2011 to a central site for you to pick up.
3. **Amount of Food:** Four produce varieties, organic bread, & farm fresh milk, eggs, and cheese in alternating weeks.
